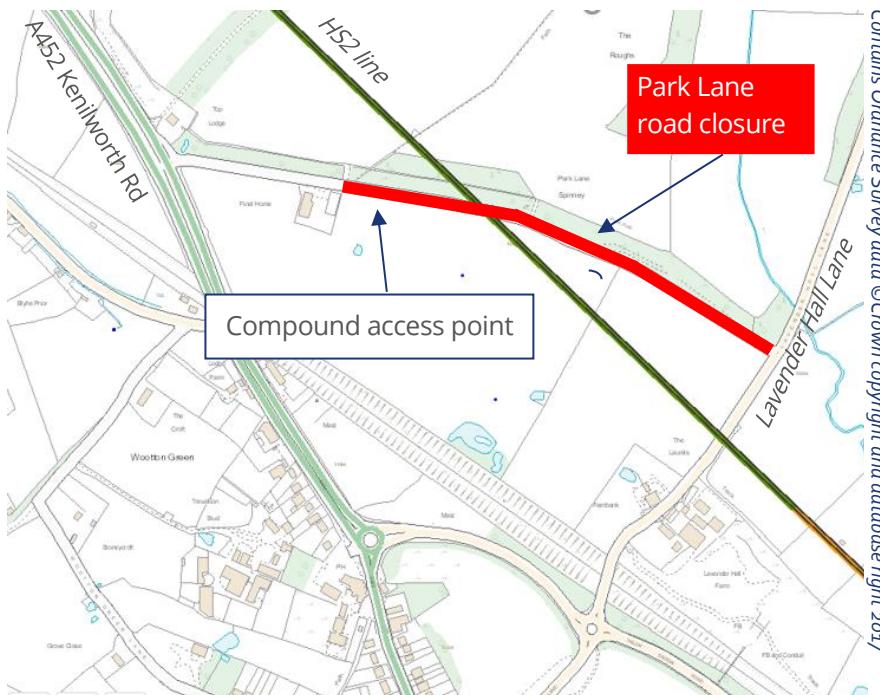
Park Lane- road closure

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Initial works have now started and are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

We will be closing Park Lane from Lavender Hall Lane to the access point for compound area (indicated on the map below) from 9 September 2019 for up to three weeks, to construct the entrance for the compound itself. The road will be closed for the entire duration of the works, 24 hours a day, with daytime working hours Monday - Friday, 8:00am to 6:00pm.

Access will be maintained for households on Park Lane from the A452 Kenilworth Road. A clearly signed local diversion will be in place. Further information is available at www.hs2insolihull.co.uk.



Duration of works

From 9 September for up to 3 weeks.

Full road closure 24/7 with working hours Mon to Fri 8.00am to 6.00pm.

Our contractors may also be on site for up to one hour beforehand and after to set up and demobilise the site.

What to expect

Some noise from on-site machinery during working hours.

Maintained access for emergency services and to properties/businesses along the route.
